About Prem Rawat

Prem Rawat, widely known by the honorary title Maharaji, has emerged as a leading voice for peace, traveling the world for more than three decades and inspiring people to find peace within. Last year, more than 1.5 million people attended his events.

Speaking at the United Nations Conference Centre in Bangkok, Thailand, he said, "It is not the world that needs peace; it is people. When people in the world are at peace within, the world will be at peace. The peace we are looking for is within. It is in the heart, waiting to be felt, and I can help you get in touch with it."

"What I offer people is not just talk," he says, "but a way to go inside and savor the peace that is within."

The dissemination of his message, which is made available in more than 88 countries and 70 languages, is supported entirely by voluntary contributions and the sale of related materials. He receives no personal remuneration whatsoever from the organizations that sponsor his speaking tours.

The Prem Rawat Foundation (TPRF) promotes Maharaji's message of peace around the world in addition to spearheading significant humanitarian initiatives to improve the quality of life for people most in need. The Foundation has donated more than a quarter of a million dollars to the United Nations World Food Programme, has organized tsunami hunger-relief efforts in Sri Lanka, conducted free medical clinics in India, and contributed to the relief of victims of Hurricane Katrina & Wilma and famine in Niger, and has supported numerous other relief efforts around the world.
